### S.H.A.P.E.

S. Spiritual Gifts What has God supernaturally gifted me to do?

E. Experiences What are key relationships, successes, or painful experiences

have shaped me?

## **Spiritual Gifts**

"Now about spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be ignorant." 1 Corinthians 12:1

A spiritual gift is a special ability given by the Holy Spirit to serve others and strengthen the Body of Christ.

Ways to Discover Our Spiritual Gifts:

- Practice: God reveals spiritual gifts to us as we minister to others.
- Read and Study: There are a number of books that talk about spiritual gifts.
- Take assessments: No test is perfect, but it can help get you started.
- Ask others for input: Others will often see gifts in us that we can't see ourselves.
